International Monetary Fund This Technical Assistance Report discusses the recommendations made by the IMF mission to assist the Central Bank of Bosnia and Herzegovina (CBBH) with the compilation of government finance statistics (GFS) in accordance with the guidelines of the Government Finance Statistics Manual 2014 (GFSM 2014) and the European System of National and Regional Accounts 2010 (ESA 2010). It was recommended that the CBBH that compiles GFS and the statistical office of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, which compiles national accounts statistics, coordinate the coding to ESA 2010. The CBBH will also examine budget items in the chart of accounts for which no unique GFS code could be assigned during the mission.

QUALITY REPORT ON NATIONAL AND REGIONAL ACCOUNTS

2016 DATA

This document presents Eurostat's assessment of the quality of the 2016 national and regional accounts submitted by the EU Member States, Iceland, Norway and Switzerland, and information on Eurostat's publications of European aggregates. This quality report contains the first assessment results since 1 September 2014, when the European System of Accounts (ESA 2010) was introduced and data started being sent according to the new methodology. In general, data sent in 2016 were in line with the ESS quality standards and the ESA 2010 Regulation. Many Member States coped relatively well with the new data requirements and methodology even if the process of adapting national data compilation systems will continue until 2020.

International Monetary Fund The global upswing in economic activity is strengthening. Global growth, which in 2016 was the weakest since the global financial crisis at 3.2 percent, is projected to rise to 3.6 percent in 2017 and to 3.7 percent in 2018. The growth forecasts for both 2017 and 2018 are 0.1 percentage point stronger compared with projections earlier this year. Broad-based upward revisions in the euro area, Japan, emerging Asia, emerging Europe, and Russia—where growth outcomes in the first half of 2017 were better than expected—more than offset downward revisions for the United States and the United Kingdom. But the recovery is not complete: while the baseline outlook is strengthening, growth remains weak in many countries, and inflation is below target in most advanced economies. Commodity exporters, especially of fuel, are particularly hard hit as their adjustment to a sharp step down in foreign earnings continues. And while short-term risks are broadly balanced, medium-term risks are still tilted to the downside. The welcome cyclical pickup in global activity thus provides an ideal window of opportunity to tackle the key policy challenges—namely to boost potential output while ensuring its benefits are broadly shared, and to build resilience against downside risks. A renewed multilateral effort is also needed to tackle the common challenges of an integrated global economy.

International Monetary Fund This technical assistance report (TA) report specifies mission's efforts to support the Bosnia and Herzegovina authorities, with a specific focus on the Republic of Srpska (RS), in improving government finance statistics (GFS) for decision making. This mission's focus has been to continue developing reconciliation processes, to develop a compilation process for nonbudgetary public sector units, and to discuss classification questions in context of GFS compilation per the European System of National and Regional Accounts 2010 and the Government Finance Statistics Manual 2014. This mission initiated the development of a standardized compilation procedure for nonbudgetary public sector units, and, more specifically extra-budgetary units. The August 2017 mission mapped out flows between the budget, the health fund, the health institutions, and patients (household), concerning the provision of health care and its funding. This mapping is expected to help serve the classification of functional expenditure of the health fund and the health care providers.

International Monetary Fund This Article IV Consultation highlights that the Dutch economy has grown faster than the euro area average over the past few years reflecting recovering consumption and investment, and strong net exports. Progress with tackling long-standing imbalances in the households and corporate sectors, and thus external imbalances, has lagged. Households remain highly leveraged and their consumption constrained by a stagnating disposable income. In the corporate sector, dominated by large multinational corporations, investment is low but savings are high, and developments are diverging with domestic small and medium enterprises relatively stagnant. Strong fiscal performance in recent years has boosted buffers that can now be used to reduce distortions and strengthen potential growth. The report recommends that it is important to harmonize tax benefits and social security contributions for different types of employment to reduce labor market duality while increasing overall labor market flexibility. Using fiscal space to address household and corporate imbalances is desirable and is unlikely to jeopardize long-term fiscal sustainability.

INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL STATISTICS, FEBRUARY 2015

International Monetary Fund This monthly issue of International Financial Statistics (IFS) is a standard source of statistics on all aspects of international and domestic finance. Information is presented in tables for specific countries and in tables for area and world aggregates. Quarterly issues of this publication provide, for 160 countries, tables with current data (or estimates) on the value of imports from and exports to their most important trading partners. In addition, similar summary tables for the world, industrial countries, and developing countries are included. The yearbook provides, for the most recent seven years, detailed trade data by country for approximately 184 countries, the world, and major areas. This annual publication provides detailed data on transactions in revenue, expense, net acquisition of assets and liabilities, other economic flows, and balances of assets and liabilities of general government and its subsectors. The data are compiled according to the framework of the 2001 Government Finance Statistics Manual, which provides for several summary measures of government fiscal performance. In IFS, exchange rates are expressed in time series of national currency units per SDR and national currency units per US dollar, or vice versa.
