Although various elements of Ten Bears's life (ca. 1790-1872) are widely known, including several versions of how the toddler Ten Bears survived the massacre of his family, other parts have not been as widely publicized, remaining instead in the collective memory of his descendants. Other narratives in this collection reference lesser-known family members. These narratives are about the historical episodes that Attocknie's family thought were worth remembering and add a unique perspective on Comanche society and tradition as experienced through several generations of his family. Kavanagh's introduction adds context to the personal narratives by discussing the process of transmission. These narratives serve multiple purposes for Comanche families and communities. Some autobiographical accounts, "recounting" brave deeds and war honors, function as validation of status claims, while others illustrate the giving of names; still others recall humorous situations, song-ridicules, slapstick, and tragedies. Such family oral histories quickly transcend specific people and events by restoring key voices to the larger historical narrative of the American West.

For millions he was much more, he was the greatest coach the game ever saw, the heir to the tradition established by Knute Rockne. He took his Alabama Crimson Tide teams to an unmatched six national championships. But to the players, journalists and fans whose lives he touched in his more than half a century as a player and coach, he was the last symbol of values that transcended football—courage, discipline, loyalty, and hard work. To his critics, Bryant represented the dark side of big-time college football—brutality, fanaticism and blind adherence to authority. The real Bear Bryant was far more complex than either his admirers or detractors knew. While maintaining a public friendship with Alabama governor George Wallace, he continually sought ways to undermine the governor's segregationist policies, finally forcing a legendary football game in Birmingham with the University of Southern California that opened the floodgates to the integration of football at the University of Alabama, including its coaching staff. Old fashioned in his politics, he was nonetheless an admirer of Robert Kennedy, whom he planning to vote for in 1968. Allen Barra's *The Last Coach* traces Paul Bryant's rise from a family of truck farmers to recognition as the most successful and influential coach in the game's history. Through it all, Bryant's influence has not only endured but prevailed as his former players and assistants continue to define the best in not only college but professional football. ### **FLAT OUT AND BLUESOME : A CULTURAL LIFE OF POLAR BEARS**

Black Dog Pub Limited Nanoq: flat out and bluesome is the story of polar bears, the largest land predators on earth, and their journey from the arctic wilderness to the museums and stately homes of the UK. Most of the dead (and sometimes living) polar bears arrived on British shores in Victorian times. They were imported speculatively into the country by arctic entrepreneurs, brought in on whaling ships, or carried back

triumphantly as souvenirs of aristocratic adventures. Stuffed and posed, the bears were placed in cases or on plinths and they have remained in these poses ever since, commanding pride of place in provincial museums, or inertly gathering dust in mansions and country houses. Between 2002 and 2004 the artists Bryndis Snæbjörnsdóttir and Mark Wilson undertook a survey of all the taxidermied polar bears in the UK. *Nanoq: flat out and bluesome* documents the histories of each of these bears, the legacies of the hunters who shot them and the skills and expertise of the taxidermists who stuffed them. *Nanoq: flatout and bluesome* includes unpublished archival photographs of hunting in the arctic at the turn of the century along with photographs by the artists of the bears in their current locations. The book also features a short story by art critic Patricia Ellis and essays by leading academics and curators, Michelle Henning, Garry Marvin and Steven Baker, who discuss taxidermy and photography, trophy hunting and the increasingly frequent use of stuffed animals in contemporary art. A unique and haunting book that charts the uneasy relationship between the wild and its representation in our museums, galleries and media, *Nanoq: flatout and bluesome* also highlights the current plight of polar bears who are facing extinction because of the destruction of their habitat.

In the Eye of the Wild is a fascinating, mind-altering book about terror, pain, endurance, and self-transformation, comparable in its intensity of perception and originality of style to J. A. The most eminent English makers, Wales, and Tolles, in America, and Hartnack, in Paris, occupy the first rank, while the average productions of respectable houses exhibit so high a degree of excellence as to make comparisons invidious. We shall not, therefore, indulge in the praises of particular firms, but simply recommend any reader entering upon microscopic study to procure an achromatic instrument, if it can be afforded, and having at least two powers, one with a focus of an inch or two thirds of an inch, and the other of half or a quarter. Cheap microscopes have usually only one eye-piece, those of a better class have two, and the best are furnished with three, or even more.
