Morphological Plant Modeling: Unleashing Geometric and Topological Potential within the Plant Sciences

Frontiers Media SA An increasing population faces the growing demand for agricultural products and accurate global climate models that account for individual plant morphologies to predict favorable human habitat. Both demands are rooted in an improved understanding of the mechanistic origins of plant development. Such understanding requires geometric and topological descriptors to characterize the phenotype of plants and its link to genotypes.
